

Maternity Case Management

Lucent Health offers obstetric care management services, including high-risk case management, to all moms-to-be. The goal of the program is to decrease preterm and complicated births and improve maternal and infant health. Patients are provided continuous education and emotional support throughout the process.

Maternity Case Management is a program that helps identify factors that put women at risk of delivering low birth weight infants, offers education and monitoring, provides access to nurses, and refers women for clinical interventions. Maternity Case Management can help our members achieve their goal of having healthy, full-term deliveries.

The Maternity Case Management program encourages all pregnant members of the health plan to participate. This is an integral component of the pregnancy management program of the health plan, as case management is established in the event of prenatal complications.

Maternity Management

Moms-to-be are registered into the program and receive a risk assessment upfront and again as needed throughout the pregnancy. Each patient is assigned a Maternity Case Management nurse, a registered nurse (RN) with a minimum of three to five years of obstetrical experience, who maintains continuing education to ensure the highest-quality care. The RN is supported by sophisticated technology to drive continuity, consistency and quality of the program.

High-Risk OB Case Management

For cases that are identified as high risk during the assessment, Lucent Health provides appropriate clinical resources to help coordinate care. The goal is to avoid unnecessary hospital stays while striving to identify the most cost-effective path of care. Our nurses serve as point-of-care coordination, while providing the patient with a continuum of education and emotional support.
